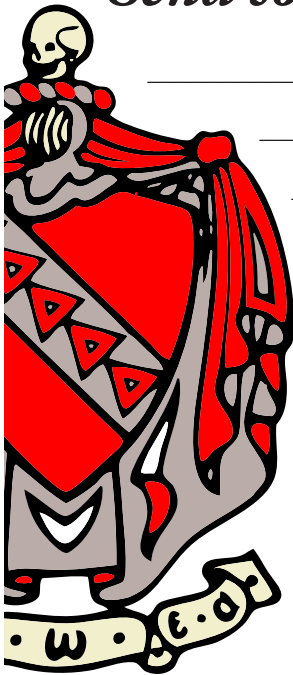

# NU CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

## National Nu-Chapter Specific Scholarships:

*These Nu Chapter specific annual scholarships are run through the TKE Educational Foundation:*

**W. Allan Herzog Scholarship:** A \$3,000 scholarship which is available to an undergraduate member of Nu Chapter of TKE, with a 2.75 GPA, who is a full-time student. This scholarship is specifically tailored towards Fraters pursuing a degree in accounting, finance or economics, and they will receive priority.

**Michael Cerussi Scholarship:** A \$200 scholarship which is awarded to a past or present jeweled officer with a GPA of at least 3.0.

**John B. Phillips Scholarship:** A \$1,700 scholarship which is available to an undergraduate member of Nu Chapter of TKE who is a full time student, is at least a sophomore, will have completed at least one year of pledge/active membership in Nu Chapter when the award is granted, has committed to living in the fraternity house at Cal during the semester the award is granted, and has a GPA of at least 3.0.

**Dr. Bud Healthcare Scholarship:** A \$2,000 scholarship, permanently endowed thanks to Dr. Bud Jamison.

## Local Nu-Chapter Scholarships:

*These annual scholarships are issued by Nu Chapter:*

**Sophus C. Goth Scholarship:** A \$600 scholarship which is available to an undergraduate member of the Nu Chapter of Tau Kappa Epsilon. The award is based on a combination of scholastic achievement and evidence of service to the Fraternity, campus community, and beyond. The award is issued annually under the direction of the Nu Chapter scholarship committee.

**Bert S. Thomas Endowment Scholarship:** Dr. Thomas left Nu Chapter a portion of his estate in 2014 in the form of an endowment fund, the income from which is to provide in perpetuity scholarships to Nu Chapter members who are full-time students in upper-divisional work at Cal and were initiated as active members of TKE prior to November

15th of the fall semester for which the award is granted. The award amounts will be determined annually by the Board of Directors based upon the earnings of the fund (current estimation of \$5,000).

**Friend of Nu Chapter Scholarship Contributions:** The Chapter has been the beneficiary of very generous scholarship contributions by a friend of Nu Chapter who does not wish to be publically identified. Based on this generosity, Nu Chapter's Scholarship Committee has been able to award multiple scholarships of \$3,000 each to deserving active members. It should be noted that there is no commitment by our donor to continue with the generosity we have recently enjoyed.

*There are up to three Candidate Scholarships issued to newly initiated members each year. Fraters are only eligible to receive one Candidate Scholarship in their lifetime.*

**Lowest Scroll Scholarship:** A \$150 scholarship which is awarded automatically to the newly initiated member who has had outstanding performance in his pledge class, with consistent dedication to leadership in his pledge class. It is awarded to the newly initiated member with the lowest numerical scroll in his pledge class. This scholarship is rewarded as long as the initiated class is at least ten members in size.

**Highest New Member GPA Scholarship:** A \$150 scholarship which is awarded automatically to the newly initiated member who had the highest GPA in his pledge semester.

This scholarship is rewarded as long as long as the initiated class is at least twelve members in size.

**New Member Community Service Scholarship:** A \$100 scholarship which is awarded automatically to the newly initiated member who has completed the highest number of community service hours during his pledge semester. This scholarship is rewarded as long as the initiated class is at least fifteen members in size.
